Workshops for Parents

Live, Love, Laugh - This fun-filled 2-hour workshop is full of family-friendly activities that promote play and the importance of laughter in a family. The workshop promotes strong bonds and open relationships that can serve as a protective factor for families.

Nurturing Infant Massage Instruction - This workshop builds parents skills and self-confidence in using massage to communicate love, relieve tension, and stimulate their baby's growth and development.

12 Steps to Keep Kids Drug Free - This workshop equips parents with practical skills to help prepare their school age children to resist the temptation to use alcohol and other drugs.

Workshops for Professionals

Basic Home Visitation Skills –Designed for the novice Home Visitor and helpful for experienced Home Visitors, this workshop addresses an array of skills required to successfully deliver family based programming in the home setting.

Ages and Stages Questionnaire—This workshop teaches professionals to support parents to use the ASQ3 to reliably identify and address developmental delays in children from one month to 5½ years with .

Community Readiness—Matching an intervention to a community's level of readiness to address an issue is absolutely essential for success. This workshop teaches professionals to use Colorado State Tri-Ethnic Center's Community Readiness Model of conducting and scoring community interviews to measure readiness in preparation of setting stage-appropriate strategies.

Trainings for Facilitators

Training model includes curriculum, facilitation skills, assessment, and program coordination

Guiding Good Choices: A multimedia substance abuse prevention program that gives parents of children ages 9–14 the knowledge and skills needed to guide their children through early adolescence. This program is designed to help parents reduce the likelihood that their children will develop problems with drugs and alcohol in adolescence.

Survival Kit for Parents: This interactive program enhances parenting skills for parents with children ages 2-21. It is designed to be presented in a series of workshops or within a church Sunday school time-slot. This program is written with biblical scriptures but can easily be adapted for presenting to a secular audience.

Nurturing God's Way: This program is ideally suited for families who embrace the beliefs of Christianity and the practices of Nurturing Parenting. The Nurturing God's Way program is an adaptation of the Nurturing Program philosophy and lessons designed and implemented specifically for parents of Christian faith.
